

Updated Terms of Reference for Faculty Members in the Graduate Program in Neuroscience

- 1. **Supervisory privileges:** Permission to supervise graduate students within the GPN is conferred by the Executive Committee through a majority vote. Permission to supervise graduate students within the GPN may be suspended, restricted, or removed, subject to a majority vote by the Executive Committee. Reasons for such action include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Three or more students supervised by the same supervisor withdraw from the program within five years.
 - b. One or more students are not receiving the current minimum stipend determined by the program.
- Minimum stipends: Students must be paid the minimum annual stipend as determined by the Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies, and by our program. <u>The current</u> <u>minimum stipends are \$22,500 for Masters students (a two-year financial commitment</u> <u>is necessary to supervise a student) and \$26,000 for doctoral students (a four-year</u> <u>financial commitment is required)</u>. - 3. Student-supervisor agreement and learning plan: Each new student must submit a signed student-supervisor agreement within two weeks of enrolling in the program. - 4. **Teaching:** Our members are obliged to teach at least one session (2 hours) in one of our team-taught courses (NRSC 500 or 501) per academic year, if asked.
- 5. **Supervisory committee service:** Members should agree to serve on student committees when possible, especially if their expertise and track record are relevant to students' research project.
- 6. **Program committee service:** Members should serve on one program committee (admissions, awards, curriculum, equity & diversity, executive), if asked. Committee membership is fixed-term; time commitment varies, but is relatively minimal.
