**Examples of common awards, minimum supervisor contributions, and resultant minimum student salaries**

**General formulae for assigning minimum contributions and salaries from awards**

<u>Award value</u>	<u>Minimum increase above baseline</u>	<u>Supervisor contribution, MSc</u>	<u>Supervisor contribution, PhD</u>
<\$4,000	Full award value	\$22,500	\$26,000
>=\$4,000 and <\$20,000	\$4,000	\$26,500-(full award value)	\$30,000-(full award value)
>=\$20,000 and <\$35,000	20% of award value	\$22,500-(80% of award value)	\$26,000-(80% of award value)
>=\$35,000	(Full award value)-(baseline salary)	\$0	\$0

**Notes**

1. All values shown are per annum, and encompass the duration the award is held
2. GPN minimums are \$22,500 for MSc students and \$26,000 for PhD students
3. When one award is held, baselines are calculated from GPN minimum; for multiple awards, each award adds own minimum increase above GPN minimum
4. Supervisor contributions listed here are for one held award. Contribution values will change if multiple awards are concurrently held.
5. Top-offs amounts listed are for competitive awards. Non-competitive awards are paid fully to the graduate student (i.e. complete top-off).
